



Printing and Photocopying

Photocopying or printing of personally owned materials is available for a fee.

Printing Rates:

- \$0.25 per black and white copy
- \$0.50 colour
- \$1.00 full page of colour

Please note that photocopying of copyright-protected materials is subject to the [Copyright Act](#). Rules and exceptions:

- **Fair dealing:** This allows for the copying of limited portions of material for specific purposes, such as research or private study, provided the use is "fair".
- **Personal use exception:** An individual can reproduce a copyright-protected work for their own use, as long as the original is a legal copy, and the device used is owned or authorized by the individual.
- **Newspaper and periodical exception:** It is not an infringement to copy a newspaper or periodical for research or private study if the material was published more than one year prior, the copy is a single copy, and the person is informed that the copy is for research or private study. This exception does not apply to works of fiction, poetry, or drama.
- **Government of Canada legislation:** The [Reproduction of Federal Law Order](#) permits copying of government statutes, regulations, and court decisions without the usual copyright restrictions, as long as you ensure accuracy and do not represent it as an official version.
